Scholarship for Eighth Grade Graduate
Application, Guidelines & Required Documents

Court St. Joseph #1642 will award one \$200 scholarship to an eighth grade student who will be entering high school at a Catholic School. This is the local court's detailed instructions for award consideration. All supporting documents required for this award as well as possible State CDA consideration can be secured from a CDA officer or the CDA Education Chairman.

Requirements:

1. Applicants (male or female) must be a registered member of The Catholic Community of East St. James Parish (St. Michael, St. Joseph, and Sacred Heart Church Parishes), complete the required Scholarship Application for submission by March 1st and comply with all other required documents, as detailed below.
2. The applicant must have an overall academic grade point average of 2.5 or higher for grade 7 and the first half of grade 8.

Documents: (These documents are identical to those required by the State CDA)

1. An application form completed and signed by the applicant. Application must also be signed by the regent of the CDA court, and the scholarship chairman. (These signatures will take place once you have returned completed application to the sponsoring court).
2. Junior High transcript for grade 7 and the first half of grade 8.
3. A copy of the student's latest achievement test scores.
4. A letter of recommendation on applicant's academic references, school involvement and character from at least two (2) members of the school's administration and/or faculty.
5. An autobiography written by the student. (Since this is a faith based scholarship, we need to know not only of your academic accomplishments but how you give of yourself, and how your faith defines you.)
6. A letter of recommendation from the regent of the local CDA court. (This letter Should be forthcoming once you turn in your application.)
